

He will discuss plans for commercial revitalization along the Liberty Road corridor. All are welcome to attend.









































Some of the items can be canned (meat, ham and chicken), peanut butter, boxed macaroni and cheese, canned (stews, tuna, salmon and sardines), nuts and seeds, dried canned beans, breakfast cereals, rice and rice cakes, pasta, canned (fruits, juices, vegetables, soups), evaporated milk, powdered milk, puddings and custards, toilet paper, plastic/paper plates and cups and utensils, infant and feminine hygiene items.
