House Republicans \$1.5 trillion tax overhaul package

1. Corporate Tax Rate Cut
2. PAYGO – \$136 Billion in cuts, will cut
 - a. \$25 Billion from Medicare in fiscal 2018
 - b. Student loans
 - c. ACA spending back up for individual insurance market
 - d. Agricultural subsidies
3. Income Tax Deductions
 - a. Eliminate Medical Expense deduction
 - b. Standard Deductions would rise to \$12,000 individuals/\$24,000 couples.
 - c. Standard Deduction for 65+ \$1,250 individual/\$2,500 couple will be eliminated
 - d. Alternative Minimum Tax would be eliminated
 - e. State and Local Tax deductions would be sharply curtailed
 - i. State and Local Property Tax would be up to \$10,000
 - ii. Mortgage Interest would be capped at \$500,00 in loans
 - iii. State and Local Income Tax would disappear

Mill Station, a new 575,000 square foot development, is scheduled to start construction in early 2018, with completion expected in early 2019. It will be constructed on the site of the former Owings Mills mall.

Costco will anchor Mill Station with a 148,000-square foot warehouse club center that includes a deli, bakery, food court, garden center, optical department, photo center and gas station.

"The \$108 million development will bring 250 jobs during the construction phase and adds to the more than \$1 billion of recent private investment in Owings Mills."

The new, open-air shopping destination will feature national, regional and local retailers, a variety of dining options, ample parking, green space and pedestrian-friendly walkways. It will house up to 30 retailers and restaurants, linked by a network of walkways and connections to existing office and retail. In addition, the existing AMC Theatre will be fully modernized, creating a state-of-the-art cinema experience.
